Sailing Uncharted Waters

Christopher Columbus, Vasco de Gama, Ferdinand Magellan, and Ponce de Leon – they all have one thing in common. They were explorers during the Age of Discovery. They sailed uncharted waters. They faced the open sea not knowing what lie ahead.

The year 2020 so far has been a murky mess of uncharted waters through which we have been forced to navigate. We were given no map or instruction manual. Little historical precedence has proved useful. We have been bombarded by contradicting messages from our leaders, the media, and even many scientists. And in these murky waters, we have made difficult choices about masks, vacations, and work.

As we head into September, many will have two difficult decisions to make: whether or not to return to worship and Sunday School at church, and whether or not to send our children to school.

Many of our families have been worshiping from home and have isolated their families. Now we have the option whether to return to worship and Sunday School. The questions we will contemplate will be many. Will we be taking unnecessary risks? Is it too soon to return? How will the continued absence of public worship and Sunday School affect the faith and lives of my family members?

Currently, our public schools are contemplating a “Phased” return to the classroom. Many of our Christian day schools are contemplating a “Face-to-Face” return to the classroom. As parents, we will be given a choice: to send our children to school, do online classes or homeschool. Like many of our families in our community and in our country, many of our families will struggle to decide which option will be best for their children. Only time will tell the consequences of all of our decisions.

Yet, no matter what happens, I pray that you will regret none of your decisions. Though we receive no direct revelation from God, you can be at peace knowing you came to your decisions in a godly way. When you face difficult decisions during this pandemic – or any time in your life – do three things.

First of all, pray. Ask God for wisdom. Ask him for peace. Ask him for courage. Then, turn to his Word for guidance and strength. Talk to your pastors. Often God tells us in his Word exactly which choice he wants us to make or gives us principles which will guide our decisions. If God’s Word gives us no direct answer, then ask yourself: Which choice best shows love to others and brings glory to God? If you prayerfully make your decision based on those three steps, you can be at peace knowing you made the right choice, even if things don’t turn out the way you would have wanted.

Honestly, we can’t see the future. We are in uncharted waters. **Yet, we can sail these murky waters with the peace knowing our Lord is in the boat with us.** He will not leave us or forsake us. He will bless us and work through our decisions made in prayer and in love. That means, however, that two Christians can go through the same process and make different decisions.

God can be glorified with the decision to attend worship and Sunday School or worship and hold Sunday School at home. He can be glorified whether we send our children to school or keep them at home. When the Bible gives us no specific direction, Christians can honestly and faithfully disagree on what is best. So be patient with those whose decisions differ from yours. Be humble. Be kind. And remember... we are all sailing through uncharted waters.

COVID-19 UPDATE

We continue to offer in person worship services: Saturday 5:00 pm, Sunday 8:00 and 10:30 am and Wednesday at noon. Now we are also adding a Wednesday 6:00 pm outdoor service beginning September 2. The Lord's Supper is celebrated at each service. The total attendance at these services, since our opening on May 30, has been about 350. We are thankful that many have returned to worship, but we also stress that if you desire to worship with us at home at this time, God bless you in that decision. If you desire to worship with us in person, God bless you in that decision.

The online worship services continue as well as the daily devotionals. We hope and pray that many will continue to make the most of these opportunities to stay close to their Savior.

Following are some basic directives for our in person worship services.

- Doors propped open to limit the need to touch surfaces.
- Sanitizer stations at the church entrance.
- Frequent cleaning of high touchpoint areas and bathrooms between services.
- Offerings are to be received on the way in or out of the service.
- We will allow about 120 worshippers in the sanctuary and chapel (and another 50 in the grand hall for overflow) - physically distanced.
- The service schedule will change as needed or warranted.
- Saturday evening services may, in time, be used for recording purposes. One or two cameras may be set up that will be focused on the pastor.

General Procedures

- Hymnals and Bibles have been removed from the pews for the time being.
- Service bulletins are available for worship. Worshippers are encouraged to take them home or throw them away upon leaving church. No re-use of bulletins.
- Custodians/volunteers disinfect hard surfaces after worship.
- Trash receptacles are available.

- Please sit in designated pews to allow for social distancing. Worshippers are asked to stagger seating in pews, allowing at least 6 feet in between. Ushers can help in this regard.
- No formal fellowship time or food or drink. Worshippers are encouraged not to come too early. Outside fellowship is encouraged with plenty of space in the parking area.

As a member, in Christian love, we ask you to:

- Please be prompt.
- Maintain social distance.
- Do not hug or shake hands.
- Wearing a mask is strongly encouraged for the health and safety of all our worshippers, until it is time to receive communion.
- Touch as little as possible to minimize risk for the next groups.
- Stay at home if you are sick.
- We encourage those in vulnerable categories to consider staying home as well.
- Use the restroom only if necessary.

Communion

- Communion elements are prepared according to health recommendations: altar guild members wear mask and gloves.
- You will receive individual communion packets.
- Pastors and communion assistants wear masks and gloves as they distribute individual communion elements to you in the pews.
- The Lord's Supper is offered in all services.

Youth Confirmation Information Meeting

Confirmation classes are fast approaching. All parents of 7th and 8th graders who will be taking confirmation classes this year are required to attend our Confirmation Information Meeting to register their children on **Tuesday, September 1, at 6:00 pm** in the Grand Hall of our new building addition. Pastor Gerbing will discuss the schedule, share what is required of parents and students, provide class materials, and answer questions parents may have. SUNDAY SCHOOL

Sunday School at Christ Evangelical Lutheran Church for the 2020-2021 school term begins September 13, 2020. In an effort to address the concerns of all of our congregation's families, both on-site and remote learning options will be offered.

New safety practices will be put in place for on-site learning. Parents, students, teachers, and pastors will be required to wear masks and practice social distancing in the Sunday School wing. All Sunday School students age 5 years and older will be required to wear a mask in the Sunday School area of the church.

All Sunday School students are to be dropped off and picked up in the lower level parking lot. Parents of children in 3K through 2nd grade may accompany their children into the building to their Sunday School classroom. These parents and students will enter the new lower level entrance, take the first hallway to the right, and drop off their children in the Fellowship Hall straight ahead at the end of the hallway.

Parents of children in 3rd through 6th grades are also asked to drop off and pick up at the new entrance in the lower level parking lot. These parents are asked to not enter the Sunday School wing unless they are also accompanying a child from 3K through 2nd grade. All children in 3rd through 6th grade will take the hallway to the left where they will find their new classrooms clearly marked.

All parents and students are asked to use the lower parking lot and new lower level entrance. A detailed explanation of new requirements and procedures will be made available to parents of on-site students after parents have signed up for on-site learning.

Parents who choose remote learning for their children will be provided with the same Sunday School materials that will be used for on-site students. Parents will receive a 13-week packet of student lessons and activity sheets. Video lessons for these students will be accessed on YouTube through our synod's Northwestern Publishing House. All video lessons are prepared by experienced Sunday School teachers for each class level. The student lesson packets are designed in such a way so parents will be able to teach each week's Bible story to their children.

Parents of Sunday School students were contacted in August to decide how their families would engage with Sunday School this fall. We will monitor these programs closely and make appropriate changes when necessary throughout the school year in order to provide as safe and effective a path as possible to educate our children in Christ's saving message.

Please pray for our parents, students, teachers, pastors and all who are helping with our Sunday School program this year.
